

Learning and studying God's word



Amplify recently shared some of the newest releases in its library. These videos are all free to First Presbyterian Church members. The website contains 1000's of study, worship, and devotional videos.

The Bible—God's Word—is our instruction manual, or our road map, for life. It contains wisdom, encouragement, comfort, and lifechanging power. And if there isn't a specific answer to a particular situation or problem, you'll find life principles that lead you to it.

I wanted to share some places to learn more about what you read. I use these sources, often when I am working on sermons or looking for ideas for Advent and Lenten studies. Please let me know what you think, especially about Amplify Media.

Amplify Media is a streaming service that delivers high quality videos with an emphasis on Wesleyan perspectives (Methodist perspective) which is similar to Presbyterian. For example, the series we used for the Lenten Study last spring was written and featured Adam Hamilton. He is a Methodist minister in Kansas City, Mo. Hamilton has several other series on Amplify Media.

Our congregation has a subscription and we have access to all the videos. Access on any device at any time for group study – all with one subscription for your entire congregation.

Amplify, as part of Cokesbury, is a trusted partner that makes it easy to stay connected and grow together as disciples of Jesus Christ.

To sign up for your own Amplify subscription, go to https:// bit.ly/3zzmbrd and enter your Amplify Access Code, BHSJGX. You will then need to enter your name, an email address, password. You will then need to confirm you password. You will not be charged or asked to enter any type of payment information as long as you use our Amplify access code to sign up. I have included a QR code to help you get started.
