

## "I am with you always, even to the end of the age"



Flat Jesus went with members this summer to Alaska, Tennessee, Texas and lots of other places. It was fun to see all the places the congregation went and the creativity that went into some of the pictures.

So, how do we continue to take Jesus with us? We learned as children that Jesus is always with us – we are told in the Scriptures after Jesus's resurrection that the disciples were asked to go to the mountain in Galilee where they found the Lord – and he instructed them before he went to heaven. This is known as the "great commission." The Commissioning of the Disciples

16 Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him, but they doubted. 18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit 20 and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Matthew 28:16-20

My hope is that each of you will continue to take Jesus with you and here are some ways we can do this

- Be a good friend: Treat others with love and respect, even if they treat you poorly.
- Pray: Offer to pray for people who are struggling, or pray with them in the name of Jesus.
- Live like Jesus: Be a living example of what the Bible says.
- Share the gospel: Speak the truth about the gospel from Scripture, and emphasize Jesus' instruction to "Love your neighbor as yourself."
- Invite others: Invite others to small group or church.
- Have conversations: Engage with others in your community about Christianity.
- Be humble: Admit when you don't know something and need to look into it more.
- Show up: Allow Christ to shine through your life by showing up in the lives of those around you.

Let's put our Flat Jesus away but continue to take Jesus with us remembering, He is with us always.

Warren's Table served 139 on September 7th. We serve again on November 5th.






